## **RE: SUMMONS ISSUED TO MINISTER P GORDHAN**

It appears that a formal process is underway with the issuance of a summons for the Minister of Finance to present himself in court on the 2<sup>nd</sup> November. At this point, South Africans must trust in the judicial process, knowing that it should only be constitutionally based principles that underpin the actions of the State.

Having said that, it is particularly important that Minister Gordhan be treated in a fair and professional manner and that he does not find himself prematurely on trial in the court of public opinion which seeks assassination of a person's character based on innuendo leaks and anonymous sources. Minister Gordhan and the South African Public deserve and are entitled to expect better.

This is especially important to do when public perceptions of a trust deficit exist.
