

PROMOTION AND PROGRESSION REQUIREMENTS

For Grade 8s and 9s to be promoted, they need:

- Code 4 (50 %+) in the Official Language
- Code 3 (40%+) in the First Additional Language
- Code 3 (40% +) in Mathematics
- Code 3 (40%+) in any THREE of the OTHER SUBJECTS
- Code 2 (30%+) in the TWO of the OTHER SUBJECTS

For Grade 10-12, the promotion requirements are:

- Code 3 (40%+) in the HOME LANGUAGE
- Code 3 (40%+) in any TWO subjects
- Code 2 (30 %+) in any THREE subjects

Minimum Admission Requirements for Higher Education

- Higher Certificate
 - National Senior Certificate (NSC)
- Diploma
 - NSC + at least 40% in four subjects, excluding Life Orientation
- Bachelor's Degree
 - NSC + at least 50% in four subjects from a **designated list (20-credit subjects)**

SUBJECT CHANGES

Learners who want to change from one subject to another or learners who want to drop an extra subject must:

- Discuss the possibility of changing / dropping subjects with the Grade Head.
- If the change is possible, the following people must sign the subject change form (available on the website):
 - The parent
 - The learner
 - The NEW subject teacher
 - The Grade Head
- The form must be handed in to Ms Joubert who will give the learner a permission slip for the change.
- Once the learner has received a permission slip, she will be allowed to attend classes for the new subject.

In Grades 8 and 9 learners may change until the end of the first week of the 2nd term, or at the beginning of Grade 9.

In Grade 10 learners may change until the end of July

In Grade 11 learners may change until the end of February

In Grade 12 learners may change until the end of January

Please take note that dates for subject changes in Grades 10-12 are determined by the WCED; therefore, the school needs the forms no later than ONE WEEK before the given date to enable us to finalize paperwork for the WCED.
