1. WELCOME



FINALS WARM UP: Warm up for finals will take place 1 hour prior to the start of finals with no allocated lanes per club.

4. COACHES AND TEAM MANAGERS:

- Only registered Coaches are permitted on pool deck for warm up;
- No coaches, team manager, parents, spectators or any other allowed on the pool deck at any time during the tournament.

5. RECORDS OFFICER:

- Control Room is *OUT OF BOUNDS* to coaches, parents and swimmers;
- No coach, parent or swimmer will be allowed in the Control Room unless they have been called by a Tournament Official;
- Only Team Managers are permitted to enter the Control Room for queries, late entries, scratching or relay entries;
- Only Team Managers may lodge objections;

6. POOL ACCESS/ENTRANCE:

- No tickets are sold at the entrance;
- All tickets to be purchased on Quicket: https://www.quicket.co.za/events/299892-ssa-regional-level-3-richards-bay/
- All swimmers, Coaches, Officials and Spectators must enter through the main entrance where swimmers, coaches and officials of the day will collect their accreditation pass to allow free entry.

7. PARKING:

- Secure parking between the pool and the school will be available daily at a cash fee of R10 per vehicle.
- Please keep your daily ticket to go in and out.

8. COMMUNICATION:

- All-important communication including results etc. will be posted on the Level 3 WhatsApp group for coaches and team managers during the event
- Results will be available on Meet Mobile.

9. CALL ROOM & STARTING AREA

- Team Managers are to ensure their swimmers report to the Call Room timeously for their event;
- Events will be announced and posted on the WhatsApp group
- Swimmers and dedicated Officials are the only persons allowed in the Call Room gazebos;
- The Call Room Marquee is out of bounds for all others;
- Starting Area is out of bounds to all Coaches, Team Managers, Parents and swimmers not in the said events.
- If any swimmer is found to be misbehaving, in contravention of the Fair Play, Dignity and Integrity ethics code, or disrespectful to the Competitors Stewart, he or she may have the swimmer removed from the event immediately.

10. GAZEBO:

• Remember to bring gazebos as shade is very limited at our pool

11. PHOTOGRAPHER:

- There will be professional photographers on pool deck.
- Kindly advise if any swimmer is opposed to having their photo taken during the event.

12. SAFEGUARDING:

• Our safeguarding officers will be on duty throughout the gala wearing a RED shirt.

13. MEDICAL:

• MedCare 911 will be on site with an ambulance.

14. SMOKING AND ALCOHOL POLICY

- In terms of the City of uMhlathuze by-laws smoking or any use of any tobacco products including Vape together with the consumption of Alcohol or under the influence thereof is prohibited in all areas of the facility;
- Should anyone be found contravening this policy a R1,000-00 fine will be issued to the guilty party or removed from the premises.
