



## SWIMMING SOUTH AFRICA LEVEL 1 COACHING COURSE REQUIREMENTS

### Coaching Competitive Swimming

Unit standard 264755

Level 4, Credits 8

#### Process to Coaching Level 1 Certification:

- Enrolment on the course must be done through the respective Provincial Education & Training Coordinators, OR visit SSA website - [www.swimsa.org](http://www.swimsa.org)
- Attend a course as stated by the affiliate.
- Course fees must be paid (including affiliate registration fee for the first year).

#### Pre-requisite:

The following are pre-requisites for attendance of the course:

- Valid First Aid Level 1 - Department of Labour approved service provider - if the certificate is older than one year, it must be accompanied by the latest CPR certificate.
- Have the latest POLICE CLEARANCE
- Swimming background is essential (a bridging course will be compulsory for candidates that would like to follow the coaching pathway and do not have LTS).
- If candidates are **not** in possession of a current SSA LTS Certificate then a **pre-assessment of swimming ability and rescue competence** must be done **before** undertaking this course. This will be at the candidates own expense.( this will not be applicable as soon as the bridging course material is available)
- To register for this qualification, candidates are required to be **18 years** of age or older.

#### The following documents must be submitted to the affiliate for registration on the course:

- 1 certified copy of First Aid Level 1 certificate- Department of Labour approved-SAQA Unit Standard- 119567
- 1 certified and dated copy of their ID
- 1 certified copy of a valid and clean FULL POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE
- ID size photo
- Proof of payment

#### Requirements for Annual Registration:

- ANNUAL registration is from the 1st May to the 31st September of each year.
- A valid FIRST AID Certificate (if older than a year it must be accompanied by a CPR renewal certificate).
- A POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE
- Payment of the PRESCRIBED FEE
- A valid SSA certificate
- The required number of CPD points.
