



To date Swimming South Africa has 6227 instructors and 737 coaches accredited and just more than 700 registered as instructors and/or coaches' in the financial year 2018-2019. Please be aware that your certificate remains valid on annual registration and submission of the required number of CPD points.

Since the 1st September 2014 SSA started printing certificates that do not have an expiry date and they are valid on submission of CPD and annual registration. Certificates printed before that must have been renewed or updated and for further information contact your Education & Training Coordinator.

CPD points must be accumulated and used for annual registration. Check the Swimming South Africa's Continuous Professional Development table which highlights various ways of accumulating points and the maximum point allocation for all the areas. Accumulation of CPD points can be done across provinces, with other sports federations and other aquatic disciplines. The more you accumulate the better as they can be carried over.

Always ask your affiliate before you register to sit on any workshops to verify the allocation of CPD points. At the end of every workshop recognized by SSA you will be given a certificate of attendance which must be redeemed when used. Keep your own records as you are responsible for your own education and training. If you don't register annually your certificate will lapse. If there are other challenges e.g. sickness, communicate with your Education & Training Coordinator in your province and they will guide you going forward. No CPD points will be recognized if they are not endorsed by your province/affiliate.
